(One Firearm Per 30-Day Purchase Limit)

Dear Chair and Members of the House Judiciary Committee:

I am a responsible, law-abiding Rhode Island gun owner and Second Amendment supporter. I respectfully ask you to **reject H7035**.

This “one-gun-a-month” limit treats every citizen like a criminal who must be rationed. Collectors, sport shooters, hunters, and families who need multiple firearms for different lawful purposes would be unfairly restricted. I do not break the law, yet this bill assumes I might if I purchase more than one firearm in a 30-day period.

Criminals do not obey purchase limits. They obtain guns illegally. This legislation only inconveniences and disarms honest citizens.

Please vote **NO** on H7035 and defend the rights of law-abiding Rhode Islanders.
