Esteemed Members of the House Judiciary Committee,

I am writing in strong support of House Bill 7753. This legislation is straightforward, necessary, and long overdue. Disarming a peace officer — or even attempting to — is an extremely dangerous act that puts officers, bystanders, and entire communities at risk. H 7753 appropriately makes it a felony to knowingly remove or attempt to remove a firearm, deadly weapon, less-lethal device, or even a communication radio from an officer performing their duties (H 7753, §11-71-1).

This bill reinforces the seriousness of interfering with law enforcement in a way that directly endangers lives. It ensures that anyone who tries to take an officer's weapon or disable their communication equipment faces meaningful consequences. Protecting the tools officers rely on to keep the public safe is essential, and H 7753 does exactly that.

For these reasons, I fully support H 7753 and urge the committee to advance this legislation.
