

The above Bills came to my attention as extremely important and they all in certain ways violate both the United States Constitution, The Rhode Island constitution, Heller, and Bruen. H-7035, This bill had a similar bill in California and was struck down by the 9th Circuit stating in Bruen it lacked Any Historical Analogue and burdening the core right to acquire arms. I ask that you do Not pass this bill on to the floor. This will garner litigation almost immediately.

H-7557, Sidesteps the Federal Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act. The Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA) is a federal law enacted in 2005 that grants broad immunity to firearm and ammunition manufacturers, distributors, dealers, and importers from civil liability lawsuits seeking damages for harm caused by the criminal or unlawful misuse of their products by third parties. Signed into law by President George W. Bush on October 26, 2005, the PLCAA was designed to prevent the gun industry from being held legally responsible for the actions of criminals who misuse firearms that function as intended. I recommend that you do Not pass this bill to the floor.

H-8071, In Heller it emphasizes that the Second Amendment protects the Right To possess firearms that are "Operable" for self defense. The key word here is "Operable" Lower courts have routinely drawn the inference: A Right to bear Arms implies the ability to make those arms functional. A Common formulation is that "without bullets the Right to Keep and Bear Arms would be meaningless. This is from the 9th circuit in "Jackson v. City and County of San Francisco (746 F.3d 953,967,2014). Again, I recommend you Not pass this bill onto the floor, there will be litigation

H-8073, Possession. This bill will no doubt garner many litigation's as it clearly violates the constitution and Heller, as well as the Federal Supremacy Clause: States cannot nullify or override federal Gun Laws. And they cannot enact laws that contradict Constitutional Protections . State laws banning firearm possession for law-abiding citizens have been struck down as violations of the Second Amendment. Some states have attempted to pass "Second Amendment Sanctuary" laws to resist federal enforcement, but these have been widely challenged and deemed unconstitutional because they attempt to nullify federal law, which is prohibited by the Supremacy Clause. This Bill should Not be passed onto the floor.

Bottom line here is that the above pending laws are all in violation of the Constitution, Heller, and Bruen. And have all had similar bills get struck down in various courts that protect our right's to Keep and Bear Arms. Our fight will Not stop because you, the people that are supposed to be representing us are doing nothing but violating our right's. We Will Not stop Our Fight. You will either lose in court, or the polling places. Please turn your attention to getting guns off the streets and going after the criminal's Not WE THE Legal LAW ABIDING PEOPLE.
