This bill, introduced on February 27, 2026, would criminalize possession of previously legal firearms effective July 1, 2026, turning law-abiding gun owners into felons overnight with penalties of up to 10 years in prison, \$10,000 fines, and forfeiture of property. legiscan.com northeastshooters.com

The 2025 ban included a grandfather clause to protect those who lawfully acquired "prohibited firearms"—including magazine-fed rifles like AR-15s, certain shotguns such as Mossberg and Remington models, and even .22LR rifles from Ruger—prior to the law's enactment. H8073 eliminates this protection, allowing only a narrow window until December 31, 2026, to sell or transfer such firearms to licensed dealers or out-of-state buyers. This retroactive measure violates due process and the principles of the Second Amendment, which states that the right to keep and bear arms "shall not be infringed." Law-abiding citizens who have responsibly exercised their constitutional rights should not face felony charges for property they owned legally.

Proponents may argue this enhances public safety, but evidence shows that broad bans on commonly owned firearms do not reduce crime, while disarming responsible owners

leaves them vulnerable. Law enforcement retains exemptions, yet average citizens—who lack such protections—are stripped of their means of self-defense. This sets a dangerous precedent: if lawmakers can revoke grandfathered rights today, what prevents future expansions to handguns, black powder rifles, or other arms? I urge you to reject H8073. Do not continue to infringe on my Constitutional rights.
