Not only is House Bill H8073 an infringement on our rights, it erases the grandfathering of certain rifles that many Rhode Islanders have owned for decades. Imagine if they made owning a car or truck with a V8 engine illegal? Or owning a home with propane heat illegal? Or having a swimming pool on your yard illegal? What would those people that had these things do? Move? Sell their property? Scrap yard?

Not only that, but there is no plan in place for after July 1st. What do I do? What are my options?

1. Become a felon
2. Turn in my rifle? Where? When? To who? The police aren't capable of collecting all of them. They don't have the resources, manpower, or storage space.
