*(Mandatory Firearm Liability Insurance)*

As a law-abiding Rhode Island gun owner and proud Second Amendment supporter, I strongly oppose **H8075**.

Requiring every firearm owner to purchase and maintain \$1,000,000 in special liability insurance is nothing more than a financial penalty designed to price responsible citizens out of exercising their constitutional rights. I have never misused a firearm, nor has any firearm I own ever harmed anyone. Yet this bill would force me to pay an ongoing tax just to keep property I already lawfully own.

Criminals do not buy insurance. They do not register their guns. They do not follow the law. Measures like H8075 only burden honest, tax-paying citizens while doing nothing to stop violent crime.
