I am writing to urge you to support the H7760 bill. I have personal experience with this offering while living with my husband. He had a very rare cancer called cutaneous T Cell Lymphoma. He had it for 5 years. After 5 different chemo therapies, there was no hope of surviving. His leg was amputated mid thigh because of this horrible cancer. It eventually created open lesions all over his body but especially on his whole head and face. He became unrecognizable. It eventually moved into his eyes and they oozed mucous and water and he could barely see. His palliative care doctor and his oncologist suggested end of life option. My husband chose this and he died peacefully and in a dignified manner. Please consider this compassionate offering for those who have no hope of surviving.

I implore you, please make every effort to pass this bill for the sake of those who are suffering miserably.
