Re: H 7106 – AN ACT RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS – LABOR RELATIONS ACT

Dear Chairman Corvese,

Thank you and the House Committee on Labor for providing the Department of Administration (the Department) the opportunity to submit comments on H 7106, which proposes amendments to the Labor Relations Act.

The Department fully supports and endeavors to protect, at all times, the right to freedom of speech as provided by the Constitution. Concurrently, the Department must balance this support against a robust body of related case law, as well as a multitude of federal and state legislation and regulations in this area. As a result, the Department must navigate a complex, changing climate to protect free speech rights for our dedicated State employees.

Specifically, H 7106 raises concerns regarding the State's ability to comply with federal requirements limiting political activity in the government workplace. Additionally, R.I. Gen. Laws § 36-4-52 prohibits classified employees from engaging in partisan politics, other than voting, during work hours. The state, as an employer, has both the obligation to reasonably comply with such statutory and regulatory schemes and protect constitutional rights. The state has, and will continue to, balance these laws while acting in its capacity as an employer to manage its workforce according to other statutory and regulatory responsibilities and powers. Passage of this legislation may cause confusion as to what speech may be allowed in the workplace.
