I have quality of like as I work 30-40hrs a week, . With this bill I will be struggling as I stay above poverty status. I will have to get another job to make ends meet. I will run my health to the ground and thats not what I want. Old and sick, poor and financially unstable.

No tipped worker ever makes less than the minimum wage for any hour worked.Survial is not \$15.00 an hour. Our menu prices will increase to sustain our income and may even impliment service fees. Guest will stray away and we will be in trouble. I will be in a bad position and so will my co-workers.

I am begging you to please, please for the betterment of our business and profession, STOP this from passing.
