RIPTA allows me to get to work reliably and stress-free, which in turn helps me be more productive in my research. As a Brown employee, I am grateful for free access to public transportation—it makes my job possible.

Beyond personal convenience, RIPTA fosters a sense of community. I often see the same people riding at the same hours, and many of them know each other. This reduces isolation and strengthens neighborhood bonds. RIPTA is also essential for those who would otherwise struggle to get around, including the elderly and disabled.

Without this bill, ridership would decline, leading to reduced service. This would be catastrophic—not only would it increase traffic but also would make it harder for many people to get to work, appointments, and daily activities. I would personally be affected, as a more complicated commute would impact my ability to do my job effectively.
