Re: Opposition to H 5507

Chairman Corvese and Members of the House Labor Committee,

As the general manager of Avvio Ristorante located in garden city Cranston, I write to express my opposition to H 5507, which would eliminate the tipped minimum wage.

There is a reason people choose tipped restaurant jobs – they know the economics are in their favor. Tipped workers take these jobs for the earning potential.

The median full-service restaurant tipped workers make nearly \$29.00/hour in Rhode Island. In my restaurant, that number can go as high as \$40/per hour.

Increasing the hourly rate will reduce the number of servers daily, which will lead to greater wait times for tables and less revenue for the business. Since it is impossible to predict the volume of business each day, we will be forced to schedule more cautiously and therefore have less servers on our payroll. With the 3-hour law we cannot send anyone home before they complete their 3-hour minimum shift, which is another reason we would be very diligent with schedules.

No tipped worker ever makes less than the prevailing minimum wage for any hour they work. Historically, when tip credit has been eliminated, the level of consumer tipping has dropped because of menu price increases or imposition of house service fees.

You may think by eliminating the tip credit you will be helping employees, but it will drastically change their earnings. The elimination of the tip credit will drastically change one of the fundamental business models in the industry, forcing me to quickly make changes to how we operate and force us to find ways to bear the cost of \$11.11 more per hour for each tipped employee. This does not include the additional payroll costs such as workers 'compensation and other costs that are directly related to payroll.

The elimination of tip credit could be a catastrophe for our industry. I respectfully ask that you oppose H 5507. Thank you for your consideration.
