I urge you to oppose H 7891 & 7989. This bill introduces rent control, just cause evictions, and a board with no safeguards against bias or inexperience. It also adds heavy regulations and costs for housing providers and developers. While it aims to help housing affordability and tenant protection, I believe it will harm landlords, tenants, and our community. Rent control can decrease housing investment, worsen rental properties, and limit affordable housing. Just cause evictions make it hard for landlords to manage properties and address issues. These policies would add unnecessary burden and bureaucracy to our tight housing market. Studies show they don't work as intended and may even benefit higher-income individuals more.
