This act is designed to provide various tax credits and relief to multiple groups of people in North Kingstown. By offering these tax credits, it acknowledges the sacrifices made by veterans, gold star parents, the legally blind, and senior citizens. Specifically:

- Veterans and Gold Star Parents: A \$200 tax credit or the equivalent assessment dollars.
- **Legally Blind**: A tax dollar credit or the equivalent assessment dollars.
- Owner-Occupied Real Property for Persons Over 65: A \$450 tax credit or the equivalent assessment dollars.

These measures can help alleviate financial burdens and show appreciation for the service and challenges faced by these individuals.
