RE: H 5968 An Act Relating to State Affairs and Government – Farmland Preservation Act

Dear Chairman Casey,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 5968, which would clarify an existing law regarding the treatment of agricultural operations with frontage on a public roadway by water and sewer utilities.

R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-82-16 prohibits any city, town, quasi-municipal corporation, or public corporation from assessing the owner of an agricultural operation having frontage on a public roadway for the extension of water and sewer utilities past the property. This law benefits farmers and owners of other agricultural operations by ensuring that they are not responsible for covering the cost of extending water and sewer lines running by their property to serve other customers. H 5968 proposes to amend the law to articulate more clearly that water utilities are prohibited from assessing any type of fee on the owner of an agricultural operation when extending water utilities past the property. DEM recommends that the language found on page 1, lines 12-15 be removed from the bill. We do not have the resources to implement this requirement and do not believe that this provision is necessary to implement the remainder of the proposed legislation.

We appreciate the opportunity to offer comments on this legislation and would be pleased to make ourselves available as needed.
