On behalf of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, I write to express our support for House Bill 5802. We believe this legislation provides a framework to help municipalities address the housing challenges facing Rhode Island. The League recognizes the need for innovative solutions that leverage available resources, and we appreciate the bill's intent to streamline the approval process for state-owned vacant properties that can be repurposed for housing.

House Bill 5802 builds upon the work of Rep. Thomas E. Noret's Commission to Study the Cost and Status of State-Owned Vacant Properties, established via House Resolution 7320Aaa (2022). This Commission, has played a critical role in evaluating state-owned vacant and abandoned properties that may be utilized for housing opportunities. By establishing a more efficient approval process, this legislation seeks to expedite the transformation of underutilized properties into much-needed housing options.

We are still in the process of gathering input from our diverse membership. Each of Rhode Island's 39 cities and towns has unique housing needs and challenges, and we are committed to ensuring that their voices are heard in shaping policy. We look forward to working with the sponsor and other stakeholders to refine the bill's language as needed to best serve our municipalities.

We appreciate your leadership on this critical issue and stand ready to collaborate in advancing policies that promote sustainable housing solutions for Rhode Island's communities.
