RE: BILL NUMBER H-5958 - AN ACT RELATING TO TOWNS AND CITIES -- ZONING ORDINANCES

Our goal is to ensure that this legislation continues to support all of Rhode Island's cities and towns while taking into account their unique characteristics and local governance needs.

We look forward to continuing to work together to refine and strengthen this important legislation.
