My name is Eric Perez, I am a multi-unit property owner resident of Providence. I am writing this letter instead of taking time off work; I can't afford to miss a day. I figured a letter with my response should be good enough. The reason for this letter is to express how I don't want bill H-6162 to pass. First, to pass this bill to re-inherit providence schools given our current city's financial struggles and woes is a premature move. We are not ready to take back providence schools from the state. I remember my attendance at both Gorge J, West elementary school and Oliver Hazard Perry Middle School respectfully. This is going back a decade and a half. Both schools were rumored to be in severe need of an overhaul due to the age of buildings and lack of maintenance and care. The lack of maintenance and care came from and underfunded school department. It's no wonder the state took providence schools from the city in the first place. For Mayor Smiley to ask us citizens who are tremendously broke for a tax increase so that he could take back Providence Schools sounds like a personal achievement for the Mayor and not of the interest of Providence.
