



# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 36

EFFECTIVE February 1, 2026

WHEREAS, Page and Parlour, to be located at 150 Broadway in Providence, will be a hybrid wine bar and bookshop operating as a “third space” and cultural salon; and

WHEREAS, If established, its owner will seek to create an atmosphere for patrons that will “walk the line between highbrow and highly welcoming”; and

WHEREAS, The prospective owner desires to offer wine by the bottle for retail sale as well as by the glass on the premises; and

WHEREAS, The nature of the proposed business does not have a singular license class encapsulating its proposed model of alcoholic beverage service; and



WHEREAS, The Providence City Council wishes to support entrepreneurship by residents that expands upon the experiential diversity befitting the appellation “The Cultural Capital”.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby supports the introduction, passage, and enactment of any legislation introduced before the General Assembly to enable the operation of Page and Parlour and future comparable businesses seeking to emulate its model of beverage service and licensure; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, if such legislation is unnecessary for the operation of Page and Parlour, the Providence City Council hereby supports the granting of whichever license or combination of licenses by the City of Providence Board of Licenses as will be necessary for the operation of Page and Parlour as envisioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon passage, copies of this resolution be sent to Senator Samuel Bell, Speaker of the Rhode Island House of Representatives K. Joseph Shekarchi, President of the Rhode Island Senate Valarie J. Lawson, and the remaining members of the Providence delegation, and Chairman of the City of Providence Board of Licenses Peter S. Mancini in expression of the support of the Council for Page and Parlour.
