
## **Caregiver Definition**





- Projected that the value of care family caregivers provide is approximately equal to expected cost of paid LTSS. (ASPE Research. Long-term Services and supports for Odder Americans 2020)

#### **Characteristics of Family Caregivers**




#### 2020 Base: Caregivers of Recipient Age 18+ (n=1,392)



# What Are Caregivers Providing?





- Depression (>50% caregivers are depressed)
- Extreme fatigue, stress, anger/frustration
- Anxiety, upset, feeling overwhelmed
- Social isolation
- Financial loss
- Physical Health problems/Morbidity
- Mortality

  - Benefits (state & federal)
  - Adult Day Services
  - Support groups
