

Regional Economic Impacts of Television Series *NOS4A2* in Rhode Island

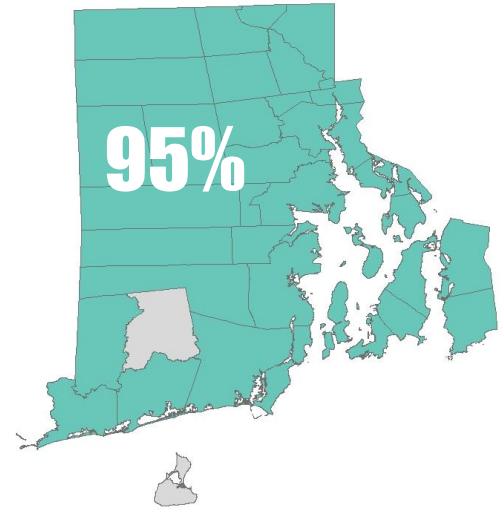
\$57 million

Expenditures during Seasons 1 and 2 of *NOS4A2* in Rhode Island that contributed directly to the state economy through payments to business and individuals in the state.

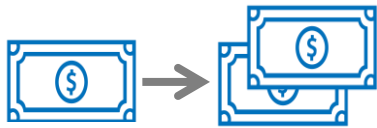
Each \$1.00 of tax credit issued by the State of Rhode Island related to the production of both seasons of *NOS4A2* generated approximately **\$5.44** of economic activity in the state.

Approximate number of full-time equivalent jobs in Rhode Island created across both seasons of *NOS4A2* by production activities.



NOS4A2 expenditures were distributed across at least 37 municipalities in Rhode Island (95% of all municipalities in the state), including many far from major metropolitan areas.

in economic activity across a wide range of industries, including rental of real estate and equipment, transportation, food and hospitality, retail, and construction.
