RE: HB 7064 - Outdoor Dining Act

Dear Chair McEntee,

Rhode Island Commerce is pleased to offer this written testimony in support of House Bill 7064, An Act Relating to Cities and Towns – Outdoor Dining Act.

Since the arrival of COVID-19 in Rhode Island, policies such as the expansion of outdoor dining capacity served as vital lifelines for our state's hospitality sector, especially the small businesses that were so severely impacted by the pandemic. Over the past four years, expanded outdoor dining has provided a key source of revenue for severely impacted restaurants and stimulated overall economic activity by increasing foot traffic in downtowns and Main Street corridors.

This proposed legislation extends the existing moratorium on outdoor dining regulations until February 15, 2025, and proposes standards for the municipal regulation of outdoor dining at food services establishments. Rhode Island's hospitality sector plays a significant role in the state's economy and the development of standards that will allow outdoor dining areas installed during the COVID-19 pandemic to remain in place after the moratorium is extinguished will help maintain the value of these investments in our main streets and downtown areas.

As such, Rhode Island Commerce is pleased to support House Bill 7064 and the safeguards this bill puts in place for the expansion of outdoor dining across our state.
