Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 5953, which would rename the fishing access point at Black Point in Narragansett after Stephen J. Medeiros. DEM supports this legislation.

Stephen J. Medeiros founded the Rhode Island Saltwater Anglers Association in 1998 and served as Executive Director of the organization for over twenty years until he passed away in late 2021. For more than two decades, Mr. Medeiros served as a passionate voice supporting the interests of recreational fishermen in Rhode Island and across southeastern New England, while also advocating for sound science to support sustainable fisheries management plans. He was also a retired officer of the West Warwick Police Department and a Navy veteran of the Vietnam War. Honoring Mr. Medeiros' legacy by renaming the fishing access point at Black Point is a fitting tribute and DEM wholeheartedly supports this proposal.
