RE: H5887 - AN ACT RELATING TO HOLIDAYS AND DAYS OF SPECIAL OBSERVANCE -- HOLIDAYS (Changes the name of the holiday on the second Monday of August from Victory Day to Peace and Remembrance Day.)

Dear Chair Alzate:

I respectfully submit this letter for the record to express the Office of Veterans Services' strong opposition to House Bill 5887. While World War II may seem like a distant chapter in history, it remains a living reality for many of Rhode Island's brave Veterans. We are fortunate that several Rhode Island Veterans from that conflict are still with us, and at present, ten World War II Veterans are receiving quality care at our state-run Veterans Home in Bristol. For them and countless military families, World War II is not a distant memory—it is a lived experience.

According to the U.S. Army Center of Military History, 1,669 Rhode Islanders made the ultimate sacrifice during World War II, giving their lives in defense of our nation. America's greatness is founded upon the service and sacrifice of these individuals, and the continued safety, security, and freedoms we enjoy today are made possible by those who continue to wear the uniform. Their sacrifices are the backbone of the freedoms we hold dear.

As our Veterans and military families' chief advocate, I view H5887 through the lenses of the Gold Star Family Experience. A "Gold Star Family" refers to the immediate family of a member of the U.S. Armed Forces who has died while serving. We must never forget, nor allow future generations to forget those who gave their lives for the freedoms we too often take for granted.

I thank you for your partnership and consideration of this letter, and I urge the Committee to oppose H5887.
