RE: Support - H8559 — Rhode Island Manufacturers Association Charity License Plate: An Act Relating to Motor and Other Vehicles — Registration of Vehicles

Dear Chairwoman Alzate:

On behalf of the Rhode Island Business Leaders Alliance, I write in strong support of H8559, which authorizes the Rhode Island Division of Motor Vehicles to make available a special charity license plate for the Rhode Island Manufacturers Association.

This legislation represents far more than the creation of a specialty plate. It is an opportunity to recognize Rhode Island's extraordinary manufacturing legacy, honor the workers and companies that helped build our state, and support the next generation of manufacturing talent.

Rhode Island is the birthplace of the American Industrial Revolution — the place where American manufacturing began. From Slater Mill to today's advanced manufacturing facilities, manufacturing has been woven into the fabric of nearly every Rhode Island family's story. For generations, Rhode Islanders have built careers, businesses, communities, and family legacies through manufacturing. Slater Mill will feature prominently on the final design.

As you can see, manufacturing is at the heart of our State and its past, present, and its future. As such, this license plate is not just symbolic — it is deeply connected to Rhode Island's identity, economy, workforce, and future.

Importantly, all proceeds from the sale of the Rhode Island Manufacturers Association charity license plate will benefit the newly created RIMA Charitable Foundation. The 501(C)(3) will support manufacturing workforce programs, training, technology advancement, innovation, and education across Rhode Island. These funds will help strengthen pathways into manufacturing careers, support current and future workers, and help ensure Rhode Island manufacturers have access to the skilled talent needed to compete and grow.

We are also entering a historic moment for manufacturing in Rhode Island. As our nation prepares to celebrate its 250th anniversary, RIMA is highlighting Rhode Island's role in 250 years of American manufacturing leadership — from the earliest days of industrial innovation to the advanced manufacturing companies shaping the future of our economy today.

This legislation provides a meaningful way for Rhode Islanders to show pride in our manufacturing heritage while directly investing in workforce development and training for the future.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge the Committee to support and advance H8559.
