

I am contacting you in support of House Bill 5716 that will eliminate the Legislative Committee that is now put in place to establish a Legislative Committee that oversees the Building Commission and the steps it takes to adopt the building and other codes. I have been told, since I have had this bill introduced, that this process is a violation of the separation of powers. The state cannot first appoint individuals to a commission and then oversee that what they have done is correct.
