Good afternoon, My name is Thomas Kaiser from Portsmouth. I support the following bills:

HB 5137- A bipartisan bill requiring the Board of Elections to verify the citizenship of all voters. First, citizenship implies a vested interest in the nation—citizens are part of the social contract, bound by its laws, taxes, and responsibilities like jury duty or potential military service. They're not just passersby; they've got skin in the game. Allowing non-citizens to vote could dilute this, giving influence to those who aren't fully tied to the country's long-term outcomes.

Second, it's about sovereignty. Elections shape a nation's direction, and historically, that's been the prerogative of its defined members—citizens. If anyone residing in a country can vote, regardless of legal status, it blurs the line between citizens and non-citizens, potentially weakening the concept of national identity and control over who gets a say.
