RE: Support for H-5084, H-5311, H-5384 (Election Admin. Bills)

Dear Chairman, Shanley and Members of the House Committee on State Government and Elections:

I am writing to request the support of the House for three bills that have widespread backing from various state and local election officials due to the improvements and minor operational adjustments they make for efficient elections administration, that will benefit local election offices:

H-5084 clarifies that the longstanding 50-foot no campaigning zone at polling locations applies to early voting in addition to Election Day polls, as has already been common practices in most cities and towns since early voting began in 2020. This is critical to ensure voters can access busy early voting sites without political interference.

H-5311 is a simple bill to codify longstanding existing practice in that the state Board of Elections handles certification for mail ballots in local special elections, a complex process which local offices are not staffed, equipped, resourced, or trained to handle.

H-5384 clears up a confusing loophole in the recount request deadline process to account for receipt and tabulation of overseas/military FPCA ballots that may change a close election result, streamlining the timeline and deadlines, which is a best practice for efficient elections administration and provides clarity to candidates.
