We feel that **house bill 5711** is not warranted. Currently the voter does provide their Date of Birth on the application, and we compare the signature on the application to the signature on the voter's record. The way the legislation is written does not allow for a process if the voter does not have either form of ID. We feel that this legislation will provide a barrier to the process for a mail ballot.
