I am writing to voice my **opposition** to House bills:

5517 - Which would increase the amount of voters a polling place could accommodate from 3,000 persons to 3,500 persons. What is the purpose of this bill? The only purpose I can see is to accommodate redistricting.

5709 - Which modernizes and streamlines the existing processes for anyone to get on the permanent mail ballot list. It is my opinion that we should be **REDUCING** the permanent mail ballot list in order to safeguard our elections. Mail balloting is highly susceptible to fraud and should be used **ONLY FOR EMERGENCY** situations and for those in the armed forces/working abroad who cannot be home to vote.
