Dear Chair Shanley:

2025 - H - 6165 An Act Relating to Military Affairs and Defense – State Police, and 2025 - H - 6188 An Act Relating to Military Affairs and Defense – State Police, establish an emergency alert system for missing persons as part of the integrated public alert and warning system (IPAWS) operated by the Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency (RIEMA).

IPAWS is a national system for local alerting that provides authenticated emergency and life-saving information to the public through mobile phones using wireless emergency alerts, to radio and television via the emergency alert system, and on the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Weather Radio. RIEMA's participation in the PURPLE alert program proposed by these bills is welcomed by RIEMA as another means of enhancing public safety and protecting lives. For these reasons, RIEMA strongly supports these bills.
