

Testimony in support of H7984: RI DOT Audit by Auditor General

To Chair Shanley and the honorable Members of the House State Government and Elections Committee:

It is prudent and good practice to perform an independent audit of organizations after major leadership changes, to make sure that a new leader starts on a "clean slate", with any inherited issues being identified so they can be addressed.

This is especially important for the RI DOT, after the previous Director resigned, and where a tug-of-war about who's actually accountable for the Washington Bridge disaster left many Rhode Islanders jaw-dropped. Conducting an audit of efficiency and performance of the Department is also prudent, because we pay a large amount of money to the DOT, and we want to make sure that the investment is not lost to inefficiencies.

This is why I support H7984.

Please bring the bill to a vote in 2026.
