Dear House State Government and Election Committee members,

I write to OPPOSE H7303 an amendment which would remove the thirty (30) day state and local residency requirements before registering to vote.

Why does this amendment undermine election integrity?

1. Reduced time for verification - time is needed to confirm age, address, and citizenship. Particularly on Election Day, verification will be rushed and there is a much greater chance of ineligible voters getting through. As a result, people could vote more than once or non-citizens could vote.
2. Vulnerability to Fraud - removing the residency threshold opens the door to "vote tourism" where people temporarily relocate (or claim to) just to influence a close race.

Again, I adamantly OPPOSE this amendment!
