Dear House State Government and Elections Committee,

I am writing to OPPOSE the following bills:

H8334 - Voting Rights Act is falsely named as it tries to subvert the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) & its purpose is to favor complaints over fair review until a court case can be heard, potentially harming the defendant or policies that can reshape the course of the election through litigation.

H7782 - Increasing the number of post-election ballot recounts increases opportunity for election fraud. There is no reason why a recount cannot be done in 7 days (or less) when the original count was made in one to two days.

H7788 - NO RANKED CHOICE VOTING!

13 states have banned RCV. RI should join them.

H7232 - Fusion voting is under the umbrella of RCV. It allows for cross-endorsement, where multiple parties can nominate the same candidate and adds too many layers of complexity to voters.
