Dear Chair Azzinaro:

I submit this letter for the record to express the Office of Veterans Services' support for H7094, which would establish the Rhode Island Orange Heart Medal and formally recognize Veterans whose service exposed them to toxic herbicides, burn pits, or other hazards like Agent Orange.

For decades, many Veterans affected by toxic exposure have suffered from serious illnesses that were misunderstood, or dismissed, leaving them without proper recognition or support. The Orange Heart Medal represents an important step in acknowledging these invisible wounds and affirming that injuries caused by toxic exposure are no less real or deserving of honor than those sustained on the battlefield.

By creating the Rhode Island Orange Heart Medal, our state has the opportunity to lead with compassion, accountability, and respect for Veterans and their families. This legislation would send a powerful message that Rhode Island recognizes the full cost of military service and is committed to honoring all who have borne it.
