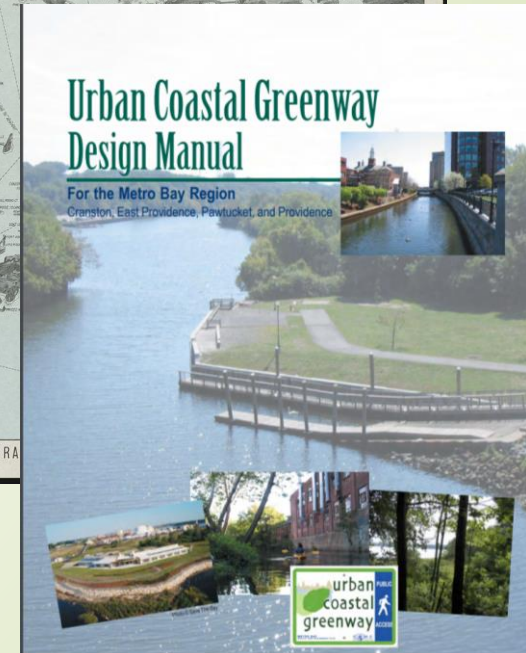
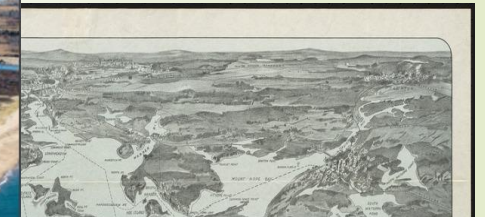
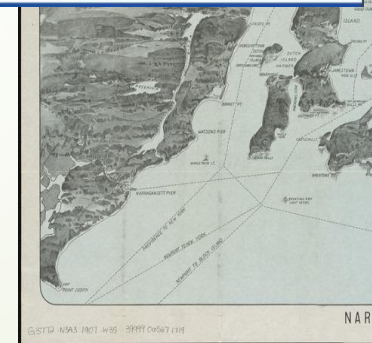
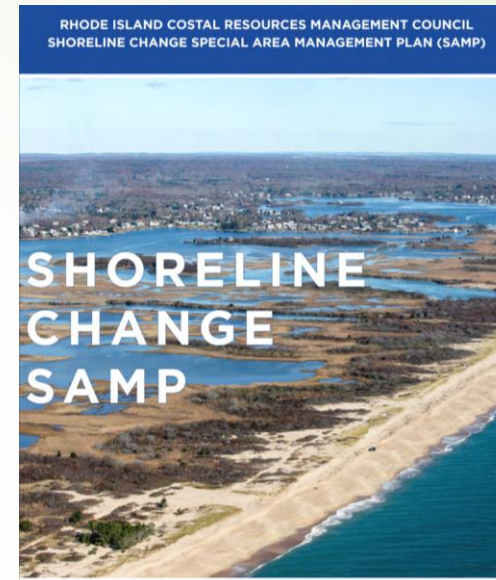
Offshore Renewable Energy

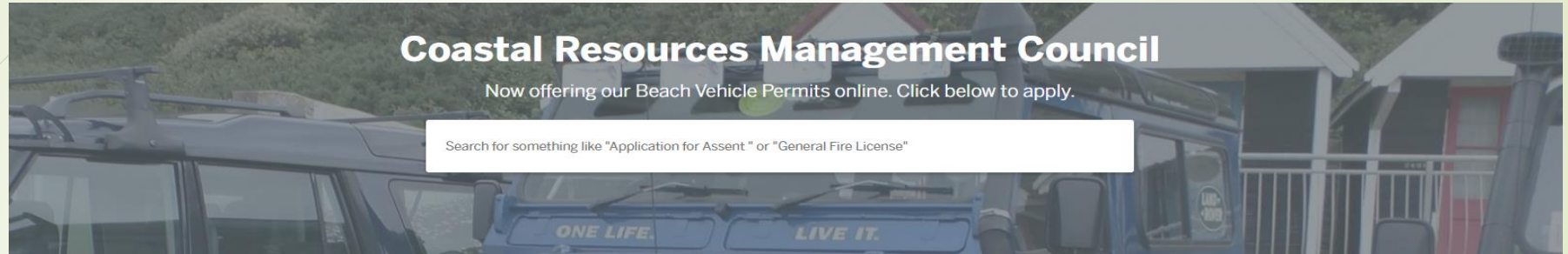

General Permit Program

- **The Old Saw: Flagpoles to Nuclear Power Plants**
- **Program Objectives: *de Minimus* Activities**
 - **Currently Issue Assents “Over the Counter”**
 - Roof Repairs/replacements
 - Pools
 - Sheds
 - Deck Replacements
 - 2nd Story Additions
 - **Find that Subset of Activities that truly need zero review oversight**
 - Compliance
 - Enforcement

Article 6, Section 8 - CRMC Penalties

- ▶ Administrative Penalty (per violation)
 - ▶ FROM: \$2,500
 - ▶ TO: \$10,000
- ▶ Each Day Violation Remains
 - ▶ FROM: \$500
 - ▶ TO: \$1,000
- ▶ Maximum (Aggregate)
 - ▶ FROM: \$10,000
 - ▶ TO: \$50,000
- ▶ Blocking of a State-Designated Right-of-Way to the Shore
 - ▶ FROM: \$500
 - ▶ TO: \$1,000
- ▶ Appeal to Superior Court
