Quarterly Report to the Joint Training Fund Committee Quarter 1: July 1, 2020-September 30, 2020

Overview

In the first quarter of the 2020-2021 year, ESF-RI was able to serve over 150 providers through professional development, community building, and technical assistance activities.

Status of State-contracted Deliverables

Professional Development

This quarter, we delivered one *Juntos Podemos* course, two *Promoting Children's Success* courses, and one Pediatric CPR/First Aid training. We served 43 family child care providers and assistants, the vast majority of whom work within CCAP programs.

Technical Assistance

This quarter, we provided Zoom technical assistance to numerous providers who needed support to be able to take advantage of our virtual trainings. We provided one-on-one business technical assistance to 102 family child care providers through our *Family Child Care Relief & Recovery Corps*. Providers developed SMART goals in areas such as business marketing, facility improvement, and grant applications.

Community Partnerships/Collaboration

This quarter, we hosted three virtual *Horas del Cafe* (Coffee Hours) for 35 providers and sent check-in postcards to approximately 400 CCAP family child care providers. The *Horas del Cafe* were welcoming spaces for any provider to attend, make connections with others, and share any of their questions or concerns as they navigated the uncertain environment created by Covid-19.

We were initially going to support DHS and 1199NE to host a series of needs assessment/advocacy calls for family child care providers, but this work was taken on by the Center for Early Learning Professionals.

Staffing

This quarter, we launched a two-month strategic planning process in partnership with All Our Kin. This process was scheduled to begin on March 26 but was postponed due to Covid-19. The process began with the full engagement of the PD Committee of family child care providers and our partners at SEIU 1199NE and DHS. Our goal remains to produce a plan, including a list of strategic priority investment areas, so that ESF-RI has a roadmap to evolve ESF-RI's training fund model into a staffed family child care network within the next three years.

We were initially scheduled to send two team members to All Our Kin's Business Train-the-Trainers Institute in September (after it had been postponed from June) but it was postponed again until November 2020.
