






### Rhode Island-Based Jobs January 2024 – March 2025





### Job Change by Industry March 2024 to March 2025





### Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rates March 2023 to March 2025








# Unemployment Rates by Sex, Race & Ethnicity 12-month average April-March





## Labor Force Participation Rates by Age for RI 12-month average April-March



### Labor Force Participation Rates by Sex & Age


12-month average April 2024 – March 2025


