Data re: Students in Foster Care: 2025-2026

The following is some high-level data regarding students in Foster Care currently enrolled in WWPS:

- Number of students in Foster Care: 35
- Number of these students with an IEP or a 504 plan: 24
- All of these students receive specialized instruction and support according to their 504 plan or IEP
- In addition to these services, these students in Foster Care also receive additional supports in the following areas:
 - Attendance Intervention: 12 (8 - tier 1; 4 tier 2)
 - These supports include: home visits, support getting to school in the morning, mentors, daily check-ins with school personnel, and family engagement.
 - Academic Interventions: 18 (9 - tier 1; 3 - tier 2; 6 - tier 3)
 - These supports include: in-classroom specialized modifications instruction, teacher assistance support, intensive inclusion support, pull-out support, and family engagement.
 - Conduct Interventions: 12 (7 - tier 1; 5 - tier 3)
 - These supports include: behavior plans, in-classroom support, social worker and guidance counselor support, mentors, local clinical engagement, in-school advisory interventions, and family engagement.

These are very general descriptions of the ongoing supports and services (tiers 1 - 3) we provide for students who are currently in foster care. Realizing their needs span a range of areas, we are continually working to increase both our in-school support and community engagement opportunities.
