4 Proposals and Provide Recommendations for Reducing the Incarceration of Women" is hereby
5 reinstated and the same members are hereby reappointed, and it is authorized to continue its study
6 and make a report to the General Assembly on or before November 10, 2023, and said
7 commission shall expire on January 6, 2024; and be it further
