

Petition from the Rhode Island Commercial Fishing Industry to the Rhode Island Coastal Resources Management Council Regarding the Vineyard Wind Fishery Mitigation Plan

Dear Council Members,

We, the undersigned members of the RI Commercial Fishing Industry, request that you reject the Vineyard Wind Fisheries Mitigation Proposal (Final Term Sheet dated February 15, 2019) and Agreement Regarding the Establishment and Funding of the Rhode Island Fisherman's Future Viability Trust conditionally signed by RI CRMC Director Grover Fugate and Vineyard Wind CEO Lars Pederson on February 21, 2019 found at http://www.crmc.ri.gov/windenergy/vineyardwind/Agreement_RIFFVT.pdf, which were recommended and approved by the Fisherman's Advisory Board at their February 23, 2019 meeting, for the following reasons:

1. The Vineyard Wind Fisheries Mitigation Proposal grossly undervalues Rhode Island commercial fisheries and commercial fishing businesses. RI DEM analysis has valued the commercial fishing activity by RI vessels in the Vineyard Wind COP area at over \$35 million ex-vessel value, a value which does not include shoreside business impacts which exponentially increases that value, expected loss of fishing gear on underwater infrastructure of the project, additional fuel necessary to steam around the project area, potential vessel losses due to radar interference, and other direct financial considerations. Vineyard Wind's proposed Direct Compensation Fund, designed to compensate "for any claims of direct impacts to Rhode Island vessels or Rhode Island Fisheries in the project area" will provide only \$4.2 million total over 29 years to cover all of these losses. Annual payments of \$76,000 a year would not even cover one claim for a net and a set of trawl doors lost on the underwater infrastructure of the project. This is an insult and is unacceptable.
2. The CRMC Fisherman's Advisory Board does not represent the Rhode Island Commercial Fishing Industry with regards to the Vineyard Wind project. The FAB does not have one member representing Rhode Island's fish dealers/processors, or any other shoreside businesses. The FAB does not have one member representing the offshore squid fishery, which is the most lucrative fishery in and around the COP area and the state's largest fishery. The most affected entities in the Rhode Island commercial fishing industry therefore went unrepresented in mitigation negotiations. This is unacceptable.
3. Vineyard Wind's Mitigation Proposal does not consider ecosystem impacts. Rhode Island commercial fishermen operating around the Block Island Wind Farm project have suffered loss of harvestable resource in and around the area since the BIWF has been in operation. The squid fishery, as well as other important fisheries, occurring in and adjacent to the Vineyard Wind project area are likely to experience significant negative impacts. This loss of resource, and therefore fishery revenue, has not even been addressed by Vineyard Wind. This is unacceptable.
4. The proposed Rhode Island Fisherman's Future Viability Trust is essentially a slush fund for non-compensation purposes. There "are no restrictions on how the funds may be used provided they further the purpose of the Trust". This purpose is to "provide funds to address concerns raised about safety and effective fishing in and around the Vineyard Wind project area and wind farms generally". The vessels and shoreside businesses suffering economic losses as a result of the Vineyard Wind project are not going to be compensated out of this Trust. However, it is this Trust that receives the lion's share of the Vineyard Wind "Mitigation" money, and envisions "programs and activities". Its board would be "determined by the FAB in consultation with CRMC staff". The FAB does not represent the affected commercial fishing interests impacted by the Vineyard Wind project, and taking the majority of the Vineyard Wind mitigation money

away from the affected public to put into a fund controlled by the same entities that negotiated the agreement is unacceptable.

5. The FAB lawyer failed to publicly disclose that she has also been retained in the past year as the legal representative of East Farm Commercial Fisheries Center of Rhode Island, an organization whose President is also a member of the FAB. This is a conflict of interest.
6. We, the affected members of the Rhode Island Commercial Fishing Industry, were not privy to the negotiations that would shape our future. We were also not privy to the documents or data used in those negotiations. This is unacceptable. All documents, data, economic reports and analysis, and copies of proposals, should have been made public for the members of the affected public to review prior to final decision by the FAB or CRMC. It is our businesses, vessels, and jobs that are being valued, and we will be the entities incurring economic loss. Fisheries mitigation agreements regarding offshore wind are, according to the Ocean SAMP, "a necessary condition of any approval or permit of a project by the Council" and "data collection and analysis, technical and financial analysis" are a part of this negotiation process, which is required by a public state regulation. This information is public information and we, the affected public, should have been furnished with this information prior to any final Council votes. We demand this access.
7. At the Feb. 23, 2019 FAB meeting held to discuss the Vineyard Wind Mitigation proposal, both CRMC Director Fugate and the Chairman of the FAB made it clear that public comment would be limited, alleging that the public had already had multiple opportunities for public comment on the mitigation. This is a lie. The FAB concluded negotiations with Vineyard Wind on Feb. 15, and CRMC signed its proposed Agreement on Feb 21. None of these documents- the Feb. 15 Vineyard Wind Fisheries Mitigation Proposal, or the CRMC Agreement- were made public until Feb. 21/22. The Feb. 23 FAB meeting was the first public meeting where affected members of the Rhode Island fishing community- those with the most to lose from the Vineyard Wind project- were given the chance to speak to the Proposal. Many Rhode Island commercial fishermen and business personnel attended that meeting in opposition to the Mitigation Plan, and were deliberately prevented from voicing their objections. Meanwhile, comment supporting the Plan was allowed. This is an unacceptable, an abuse of public process, and also represents a departure from previous FAB meeting procedure where extended public comments were taken on previous mitigation proposals by Vineyard Wind.
8. At an informal, private meeting organized by the FAB on Feb 21, which was not public but whose organizers kicked out the media and Rhode Island statehouse representatives who came to attend, the commercial fishing industry was told they would have time to publicly comment on the Proposal at the Feb. 23 FAB meeting. We were not given that opportunity.
9. Vineyard Wind is the first offshore wind project in federal waters, and as such sets precedence for how mitigation will occur in the future. If our industry is not taken seriously, appropriately compensated at this stage, and the mitigation procedure conducted in an open and transparent manner, other future offshore wind project mitigations will follow suit; to the detriment of our businesses and jobs.

We, the undersigned, will suffer real economic losses as a result of the Vineyard Wind Project which are in no way appropriately mitigated by the Vineyard Wind Fisheries Mitigation Proposal. We demand fair treatment. We therefore request that the Rhode Island Coastal Resources Management Council reject the Vineyard Wind Fisheries Mitigation Proposal at their Feb. 26, 2019 meeting.
