- Prosecutor of all criminal felony cases and misdemeanor appeals
- Represents all state agencies, departments, and commissions
- Initiates litigation to protect the interest of Rhode Island citizens

- > Includes four programs:
  - Criminal Prosecution of felony cases and misdemeanor appeals
  - Civil Lawsuits brought against the state, agencies, boards and commissions
  - Bureau of Criminal Identification Criminal history information, conducts background checks
  - General Administrative Support

# FY 2013 Changes to Enacted

- Purchased Technology Services
  - \*\$147,188 from general revenues
    - ✓ Project Coordinator to oversee database upgrades
  - \*\$28,677 from general revenues for FY 2014
    - ✓ Partially offset by grant funds
  - Governor recommends funding as requested, for both FY 2013 and FY 2014

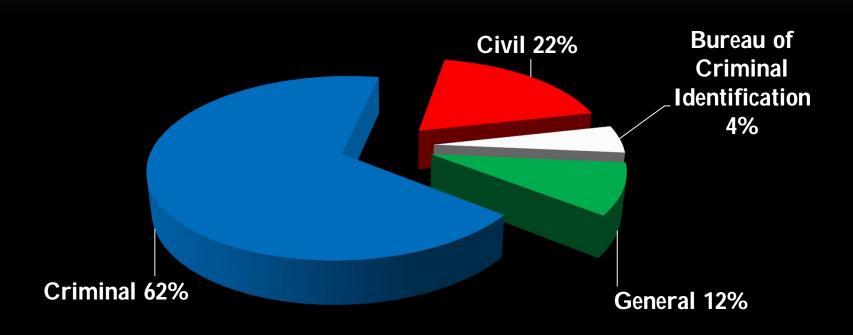
# FY 2013 Changes to Enacted

- Background Checks Grant
  - \*\$1.1 million from federal funds
    - ✓ Fingerprint of Healthcare Workers
  - \*\$180,969 from federal funds for FY 2014
- > \$0.1 million in federal funds
  - Criminal Division Database Upgrade
- > \$0.2 million from restricted receipts
  - Civil Division Database Upgrade
    - ✓ Not part of the Enacted

## Google Settlement

- Office to receive \$60.0 million from settlement
  - ◆ \$4.0 million for FY 2014
    - √\$2.0 million for FY 2013
  - Not yet identified projects
  - Office is still developing a plan
  - Funds are awarded for approved projects only

# Google Settlement

- > One-time revenue, available for multiple years
  - Office space within the Judicial Complexes
  - Parking has been an issue for the Office
  - Other building repairs and renovations
    - ✓ Plan may include purchase need assessment services

#### Foreclosure Assistance

- Office to receive \$4.0 million from National Mortgage Settlement
  - Stabilize housing market through foreclosure assistance
  - Governor's FY 2013 revised & FY 2014 budgets remove the funds
    - Consistent with the Office's budget requests

## Foreclosure Assistance

- Office would want to create an escrow account
  - Assumes funds can be deposited or withdrawn for foreclosure
    - ✓Office remains in charge of funding all foreclosure matters/expenses
    - ✓ These funds should be part of the appropriations

# Salaries and Benefits Staffing

- ➤ Governor recommends \$23.7 million from all funds for 233.1 full-time positions for FY 2014
  - \*\$21.6 million from general revenues
  - Consistent with FY 2013 revised recommended level of authorized positions
- ➤ Governor includes \$22.9 million for FY 2013
  - \*\$20.7 million from general revenues

## Staffing

- ➤ Governor's recommendation is \$0.5 million more than enacted from all funds for FY 2014
  - \*\$0.5 million more from general revenues
    - ✓\$0.2 million from turnover savings
    - √\$0.1 million from statewide benefit savings
  - Offset by current service adjustment
    - ✓ Updated benefit rates

## Staffing

- ➤ Governor's recommendation is \$0.3 million less than enacted from all funds for FY 2013
  - \*\$0.3 million less from general revenues
    - ✓\$0.2 million from turnover savings
    - ✓\$0.1 million from statewide medical benefit savings

#### Staffing Request

- Office requested \$0.7 million from general revenues for FY 2013 and FY 2014
  - Fill 8.0 additional full-time positions
    - ✓ 4.0 attorneys, 2.0 paralegal clerks, 1.0 legal assistant, 1.0 administrative aide
  - Neither the funds nor the positions were recommended by the Governor

#### Funded Positions

- ➤ Enacted includes savings of \$0.4 million from turnover and appears to fund 228.8 positions
- ➤ Governor's budget assumes \$0.9 million in turnover savings and appears to fund 223.4 positions
  - ❖ Recommended turnover assumption is consistent with FY 2013 Governor revised

## Other Operations

➤ Governor includes \$2.4 million from all funds for all other operating expenses for FY 2014

## Other Operations: General Revenues

- \$18,419 for delivery services
  - ✓\$69,582 less than enacted, \$685 less than requested
- \*\$48,422 for internet services
  - ✓\$48,067 more than enacted, as requested
- \*\$29,414 for software maintenance agreements
  - ✓\$24,837 more than enacted, as requested
- \* \$241,388 for maintenance
  - √ \$20,480 more than enacted, \$10,690 less than requested

## Other Operations

- \*\$\\$6,796 from federal funds for equipment, data-entry & financial services
  - ✓\$61,587 less than enacted
- \$183,872 from restricted receipt forfeitures for vehicle purchases
  - √\$69,422 more than enacted
- \$49,929 in restricted receipt public utilities, enacted for expert engineering services
  - ✓\$96,387 less than enacted

## Capital Projects

- ➤ Governor includes \$0.7 million from RICAP for the five-year period
  - ✓\$50,000 less than previously approved levels
  - \*\$50,000 for FY 2014
  - \$0.6 million for FY 2013 revised
    - ✓\$312,500 more than enacted
  - Primarily for water seepage in basement level of facility

# Capital Projects

- > Funds for:
  - General interior renovations
  - Elevator and security system upgrades
  - Exterior re-pointing of the building
  - Building's piping infrastructure upgrade
  - HVAC system upgrades
  - Upgrading the Automated Fingerprint Identification System
