Salaries and Benefits

- Recommends \$3.8 million in FY 2014 revised and \$4.0 million in FY 2015 for staffing
 - Revised is \$19,367 less than requested, statewide medical benefit savings
 - FY 2015 is \$24,814 more than enacted for current service adjustments
