  - > GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

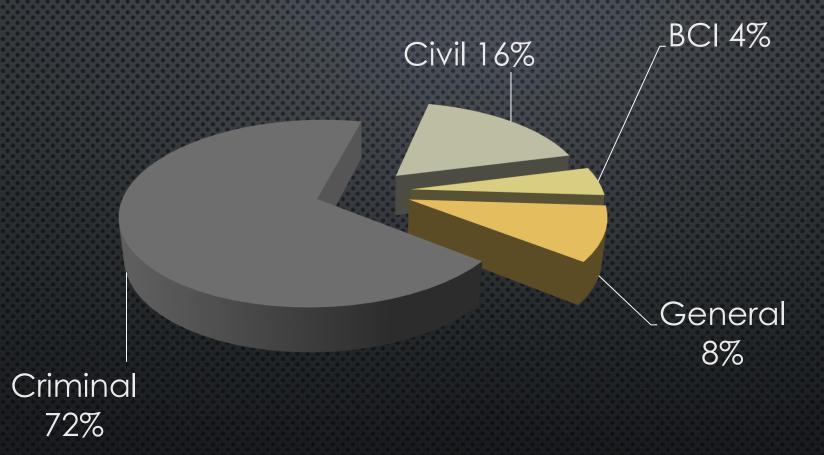

#### Budget Office Target

- ➤ GENERAL REVENUE TARGET OF \$23.3 MILLION
  - ➤ CURRENT SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS OF \$16,754
  - > 7.5% TARGET REDUCTION OF \$1.9 MILLION
    - ✓ OFFICE INCLUDED PAY UPGRADES AND NEW POSITIONS
    - ✓ ELIMINATED UPGRADES AND POSITIONS FROM THE CONSTRAINED BUDGET
- CONSTRAINED BUDGET IS \$2.8 MILLION ABOVE TARGET
- ➤ GOVERNOR RECOMMENDED BUDGET EXCEEDS TARGET BY \$2.3 MILLION

- > Office received \$60.0 million from settlement
- > Spent \$11.2 million through March 2016
  - > PURCHASED NEW BUILDING & OTHER REPAIRS
  - > BALANCE OF \$48.8 MILLION
- ➤ Governor includes \$5.3 million for FY 2016 & \$6.0 million for FY 2017
- >OFFICE HAS SUBMITTED NEW PLANS FOR FEDERAL APPROVAL

- New Customer service Center at the Pastore Complex
  - ➤ BETWEEN \$10 MILLION TO \$11 MILLION
- > RENOVATIONS TO 150 MAIN STREET
  - ➤ PROJECTIONS BETWEEN \$3.0 MILLION TO \$5.0 MILLION
- > BALANCE OF APPROXIMATELY \$33 MILLION

- > FORFEITURE FUNDS RECEIVED ACCORDING TO FEDERAL GUIDE TO EQUITABLE SHARING
  - MUST INCREASE OR SUPPLEMENT RESOURCES
  - > CANNOT REPLACE OR SUPPLANT EXISTING RESOURCES
  - > EXPENDITURES MUST BE PRE-APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
    - SOME LATITUDE ON PROGRAMS AND PURCHASES IN SUPPORT OF CRIME PREVENTION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

- > Uses include law enforcement investigations, training and equipment
- DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAMS, COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAMS AND TRANSFERS TO OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

#### Pension Settlement Lawsuit

- >FY 2016 ENACTED BUDGET INCLUDES \$250,000 IN ATTORNEY GENERAL'S BUDGET
- > DEFEND THE STATE IN LAWSUIT FILED BY PENSIONERS
- > NO FUNDS WERE EXPENDED IN FY 2015
- ➤ GOVERNOR ELIMINATES FUNDING IN FY 2016
  REVISED & FY 2017 RECOMMENDED BUDGET
- CRANSTON POLICE & FIREFIGHTERS HAVE FILED SUIT IN FEDERAL COURT STATE HAS NOT BEEN SERVED

#### Background Check

- ➤ GOVERNOR INCLUDES \$2.0 MILLION FROM
  FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT
  IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM & INCORPORATE THE
  NATIONAL BACKGROUND CHECK INITIATIVE
  - > IN FY 2016 REVISED BUDGET
- ➤ Governor also includes \$0.3 million in unused bond

#### Background Check

- PERFORM BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR HEALTH CARE WORKERS WHO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE STATE'S CHILDREN AND ELDERLY
- > \$35 CHARGE FOR FINGERPRINT CHECK
- > AG'S OFFICE DOES NOT CHARGE \$35 EACH TIME IF
  CONTINUALLY EMPLOYED FOR 5 YEARS IN THE INDUSTRY
  - > 5-YEAR RENEWAL THAT MUST DONE
- > CHECKS ARE REQUIRED EACH TIME THERE IS A NEW EMPLOYER

#### Tobacco Litigation

- STATE IS DEFENDING ITSELF IN A CASE BROUGHT BY TOBACCO PRODUCTS MANUFACTURERS
  - > CONTESTING ENFORCEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT AS IT PERTAINS TO NON-PARTICIPATING MANUFACTURERS
- ➤ GOVERNOR RECOMMENDS \$104,465 FOR FY 2016 REVISED AND \$40,000 IN FY 2017
- SPENT \$35,536 IN FY 2015, \$35,097 IN FY 2014 AND \$7,391 IN FY 2013

#### Staffing

- >Office's FY 2017 request adds 7.0 positions
  - ➤ STAFF ATTORNEY, PARALEGALS, INVESTIGATOR, FINGERPRINT EXPERT & LEGAL SECRETARY
  - > \$0.5 MILLION FROM GENERAL REVENUES
- > ALSO INCLUDES POSITION UPGRADES
  - >\$1.2 MILLION FROM ALL FUNDS
  - >\$1.1 MILLION FROM GENERAL REVENUES
- >The Governor did not recommend the new positions or upgrades

#### Capital Projects

- ➤ GOVERNOR INCLUDES \$0.9 MILLION FROM RICAP FOR THE FIVE-YEAR PERIOD
  - > \$300,000 FOR FY 2016 REVISED & FY 2017
  - > \$150,000 ANNUALLY FOR FY 2018 THROUGH FY 2021
  - > Primarily for HVAC upgrades and office space renovations

#### Capital Projects

- > FUNDS FOR:
  - > HVAC SYSTEM UPGRADES
  - > GENERAL INTERIOR RENOVATIONS
  - > ELEVATOR AND SECURITY SYSTEM UPGRADES
  - > EXTERIOR RE-POINTING OF THE BUILDING
  - > BUILDING'S PIPING INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

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
