I'm writing as a parent to urge you to withdraw S 3010 and support S 2216 to better protect our students.

S 3010 focuses on cleanup after harm occurs, expands a secret list system, and leaves critical gaps, especially for non-tenured/probationary teachers, who make up many new hires. It risks allowing concerning individuals to move between districts without detection and keeps parents in the dark.

S 2216, by contrast, screens all adults working with students, catches red flags early, and provides real accountability without secrecy or gaps.

Please prioritize prevention and transparency by supporting S 2216.
