Dear Chairwoman Sosnowski,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on S 3150, which would establish a Strengthen Rhody Homes program. DEM supports this legislation.

The Strengthen Rhody Homes program proposed by this legislation would assist homeowners to harden their home to protect against extreme weather events. The program would utilize science-based standards developed by the Insurance Institute for Business and Home Safety including measures to secure the roof deck, provide impact protection for windows and doors, and protect vents and soffits. The implementation of such improvements will provide enhanced protection for homeowners against extreme weather events and may result in reduced home insurance premiums. We urge the General Assembly to move forward with this important legislation.
