

Trafton testimony in behalf of the Environment Council of Rhode Island supporting S2244 - Senate Finance Committee, May 21, 2026.

Dear Chair DiPalma and Honorable Committee Members,

I'm Peter Trafton from Providence, Co-VP of Policy for the Environment Council of Rhode Island (ECRI) writing in strong **support of S 2244**, by Senator Valverde and colleagues.

This bill exempts Rhode Island sales tax for behind the meter batteries used as part of a solar photovoltaic system. Essentially all other components of solar systems that Rhode Islanders seek to place on their roofs have this exemption. The Trump administration's policies have removed various subsidies for clean energy. It would be most appropriate for our state to grant this small bit of assistance to Rhode Islanders efforts to move from costly polluting fossil fuel to money-saving, healthy renewable energy such as that produced by solar systems.

ECRI urges you to pass 2244 to add a small amount of assistance to a public good.
