Dear Chairman DiPalma and Members of the Senate Finance Committee,

I am writing to express strong support for S2252 sponsored by Senator Meghan Kallman, which would allocate \$75,000 in FY27 to Jewish Collaborative Services (JCS).

JCS is a nonprofit that provides critical aid and assistance to thousands of Rhode Islanders each year. We support individuals and families facing serious physical, mental, and financial challenges with a full continuum of services. When neighbors experience hardship, JCS intervenes with care, connection, and understanding helping people to achieve stability again.

However, rising costs and the ongoing fallout from federal policy changes that restrict access to essential benefits keep placing significant strain on our programs. Our food security programs are especially becoming difficult to sustain in the face of increased costs but also increased demand.

JCS plays a unique and irreplaceable role in our state. It is the only housing and social services agency in Rhode Island that directly serves the Jewish community. For example, JCS operates the state's only kosher food pantry, kosher meal site program, and kosher meal delivery for homebound individuals. For those who rely on these services, there are no alternative providers that can meet their dietary, cultural, and religious needs. Any reduction in resources would leave these Rhode Islanders without access to essential support.

In passing S2252, the state will reaffirm its commitment not only to the Jewish community, but to all those facing hardship. You will ensure that JCS continues to serve those with nowhere else to go. Such investment turns despair into hope. Thank you for your consideration and for your continued commitment to the well-being of all Rhode Islanders. Please give S2252 your full support.
