RE: In support of Senate Bill 3214, An Act Relating to Education – School Committees and Superintendents

Dear Chair DiPalma,

As a longtime public educator, I write in support of Senate Bill 3214, which would both restore local governance of the Central Falls School District and ensure the sustainability and predictability of district funding. This legislation finally gives the people of Central Falls—families, educators, and local leaders—a voice in the future of their schools.

It is imperative that the Central Falls Schools are governed in a way that fully represents the community and their needs. A local school board, by its nature, is the body politic most closely related to the students, families, and educators of a community, and therefore the most responsive to their needs. The democratic nature of a school board allows the community's voices to be heard and holds policymakers accountable. The students, families, and educators of Central Falls deserve to have that voice once again.

Senate Bill 3214 repeals the structure governing the Central Falls School District board of trustees, creates a pathway for local control, maintains the city-state's partnership, and establishes a fund that would ensure student support and fiscal responsibility. The passage of this legislation will empower those who know the students and the community best and encourage accountability, transparency, and direct investment in children's success.

Therefore, I urge this committee and the full Senate to support Senate Bill 3214, as it will guarantee families, educators, and local leaders shape the future of the city's schools, while also providing a fiscally responsible path forward.
