Re: Testimony in Support of S 3367

Dear Chairman Senator DiPalma and Members of the Senate Finance Committee:

On behalf of the Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council (WRWC), I am writing to support S 3367.

As the head of a Rhode Island non-profit organization that provides incredibly effective adult leadership programming and climate action opportunities for adults, we serve hundreds of Rhode Island residents whom we compensate for their participation, usually at a rate of \$25/hour. Our core programs such as Nuevas Voces and Mi Arbol include about 100+ Rhode Island adults annually, and depending on the length of the programs, most participants receive between \$400 and \$500 throughout the course of their programs.

When we received the letter from the division of taxation requiring us to fill out paperwork for every person that received more than \$100 from WRWC as a program participant, we were quite concerned about pulling together so much paperwork. It would have been cumbersome for our participants as well as our finance staff.
