**RE: S2107 Oppose**

Dear Chairwoman Murray and Members of the Committee,

On behalf of LeadingAge Connecticut & Rhode Island, I write to respectfully express our opposition to S2107, An Act Relating to Health and Safety - Healthcare Worker Platform Act.

LeadingAge Connecticut & Rhode Island represents nonprofit nursing homes and mission-driven aging service providers that serve Rhode Island's most vulnerable residents. Our members are deeply committed to transparency, accountability, and high-quality care. It is for that reason that we are concerned that S2107, as currently drafted, may have unintended consequences that could negatively impact providers' ability to operate sustainably.

Specifically, the bill proposes to exclude a "healthcare worker platform" from the regulations and oversight imposed on all other nursing service agencies. If enacted, this proposal would allow these platforms, which we believe are truly nursing service agencies, to avoid the current statutory caps placed on the nursing agency charges to aging service providers. It would also allow them to avoid the regulatory oversight of the RIDOH which is in place to protect the clients, residents and patients of aging service providers. We cannot support this proposal.

We respectfully urge the Committee to reject S2107.
